

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
SECOND MEETING, 2024 SESSION (2)
JANUARY 4, 2024**

The board broke for lunch at 12:00 p.m. The Board reconvened at 12:30 pm to hear the remainder of the FY'24 budgets.

Buena Vista County Historical & Genealogy Association- Lucille Fitzsenry and Kristin Watts reviewed the past year and presented the group with their request for FY25. The main highlight was on the Book Nook and how they hoped to expand on that. They told the group that they continue to sell books outside of the Spring and Fall book sales.
