Note: Actual/Assessed Valuation is multiplied by a Rollback Percentage to get to the Taxable Valuation to calculate Property Taxes. Residential and Commercial properties have the same Rollback Percentage at \$150,000 Actual/Assessed Valuation. The Proposed Property taxes assume a 10% increase in property values for the year as a comparison to the current year.

Reasons for tax increase if proposed exceeds the current:

The increase in tax dollars is due to increased costs of continuing necessary services to the public, along with increased health insurance, property insurance, tort liability, & safety of workplace, along with unfunded MWWS. The 65+ Homestead & Military exemptions reduced valuations by \$1.0M
