A demonstrated knowledge of regulations, policies, budgeting, and finance are also required, along with familiarity with local public health laws/codes and the proper use of authority in a public health emergency. Excellent verbal, written, and computer skills are a must. You must possess a valid driver's license and have access to a motor vehicle. NIMS training, Dependent Adult and Child Abuse training, and BLS certification are required after hire.

This is a tremendous opportunity to demonstrate your commitment to advancing polices that promote and improve health outcomes and strengthen both public health infrastructure and the health of the community.
