- Our clinics are walk in, however we encourage you to make an appointment to avoid long wait times.
- Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to sign papers.
- No prescription is necessary but you must bring your immunization record with you.
- If you have Medicaid, please bring your insurance cards.
- Immunization can be given if child has a slight cold or on antibiotics, however no fever.
- Boosters for children entering school may be given after 4 years of age.
- A \$10 donation per vaccine is suggested to help defray the costs.
- If you have HAWKI insurance you must get your vaccines at the Dr. Office.
- TB Mantaoux is **NOT** a part of immunizations. There is a **\$30 fee.**

Buena Vista County Public Health may give immunizations according to the VFC schedule to any children; infant through 18 years of age who are:

- Enrolled in Medicaid
- Have no insurance
- Health insurance doesn't cover vaccines
- American Indian or Alaskan Native

CHILDREN WHOSE HEALTH INSURANCE COVERS THE COST OF VACCINATIONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR VFC VACCINES EVEN WHEN A CLAIM FOR THE COST OF THE VACCINE AND ITS ADMINISTRATION WOULD BE DENIED FOR PAYMENT BY THE INSURANCE CARRIER BECAUSE THE PLAN HAS A HIGH DEDUCTIBLE THAT HAS NOT BEEN MET.
